Paper formatting requirements

- The paper should be typed in A4 format using a text editor Word, all margins – 2,5 cm
- File name – first author's name, surname and number of working topic (For example, Kartvelishvili -2)
- Used fonts: for papers in Georgian - Sylfaen, for papers in Polish, English and Russian - Times New Roman. Line spacing - 1,0
- Formulas should be printed in Microsoft Equation Editor
- Graphic materials should be compatible with program Word
- The title of paper should be written on the first line (13 Pt, Bold)
- The surnames and initials of the authors skipping one line (12 Pt, Bold)
- Brief summary (11 Pt, italic, no more than 600 symbols), skipping one line
- Key words - skipping one line

- Main text - skipping one line (11 Pt)
- References (11 Pt) - skipping one line
- Volume of paper – 3-7 pages
- References to the used literature sources must meet the standard: ISO690, PN-ISO690 (Vancouver system)

At the first stage, the registration card and brief summary of paper should be sent by e-mail. Once the authors had sent full paper, they will be informed about receiving them. After the mentioned procedure, the authors will send to the Organizing Committee a copy of the receipt of payment (PDF format). Names of both files (paper and a copy of the receipt of payment) should be written in the following manner: first author's surname and number of working topic (for example, Kartvelishvili – 2).

The papers, which do not meet to the above requirements will not be considered by the conference organizers.
